There are several items we still need at the shelter and you can help! If you are able to donate any of the following items, please call 539-6074.

Items Still Needed:

- Monetary donations toward pet food or Royal Canine food (Royal Canine is preferred due to its nutrients, digestion benefits, & it results in healthier animals)
- Medication toward neutering and vaccinations
- Buckets, mops, & brooms
- DAC, Dettol, & Clorox bleach
- Collars and leads
- Chewing bones & treats
- Pet shampoo & grooming tools
- Metal dustpans & metal scoopers for cleaning cages
- Frontline donations

Pesticides!

If you reside in a villa or flat where regular visits are made to spray your residence with pesticides please be aware many of the chemicals used in the pesticides may not be safe for your pet. Please make sure you know exactly what is being used and whether it is safe for animals. If the pest control technician does not know, you may want or need to refuse this service for the health and safety of your pet.
